After discovering that American lawyers provided deliberately false, politically motivated information, Interpol, the International Criminal Police Organisation, verifies here that the false information concerning Mark Inglin was removed from Interpol files and that no arrest warrant exists.

The false information was intended to cause fear among those who came in contact with Inglin, and to create travel difficulties. After providing Interpol with the false information, lawyers claimed on the internet that Inglin was "armed and dangerous." The false information was motivated by publications that exposed American legal system corruption: Beyond-Outrage (www.beyond-outrage.com) and Lawyers Broken Bad (www.lawyersbrokenbad.com).

The information was removed following Interpol's own investigation. The provision of false information to Interpol represented a desperate attempt to silence a long-time critic of the American legal system outside of American jurisdiction.
